## About the Artists

**Derek Ganong** is a trumpeter, collaborator, engineer, and educator who is dedicated to breaking down the boundaries between genres, disciplines, audiences, and artists. Equally committed to both education and performance, Derek serves as a mentor for students and an advocate for innovation in higher education through his position as Assistant Professor of Trumpet and Director of Jazz at Boise State University. Derek is internationally known for his multifaceted skills and is frequently in demand for both his music production experience and as a trumpeter with the skills and abilities to perform at the highest level in all musical settings. Dr. Ganong is currently the principal trumpet of the Boise Baroque Orchestra, Opera Idaho, and is the Eb Soprano cornet for the Brass Band of the Treasure Valley. He is also a founding member of Newstream Brass, the Treasure Valley Jazz All Stars, and is the chief technology Officer and trumpet faculty member of the Brass Institutes of America.

**Kim Ganong** is an oboe and English horn player currently residing in Boise, Idaho. She holds a Doctor of Musical Arts from the University of Miami in oboe performance with a cognate in musicology. Dr. Ganong is currently on faculty at Boise State University and the College of Idaho; she also runs a private oboe studio and reed-making business. Her other alma maters include California Institute of the Arts (BFA) and New York University (MM). Kim is also a proud alumnus of the Interlochen Arts Academy. Dr. G can be heard performing as principal oboe in the Boise Baroque Orchestra and as a frequent guest in many other groups around the Treasure Valley including the Boise Philharmonic and Opera Idaho. She also serves as the Secretary-Treasurer of the local musicians' union (AFM Local 423). Kim previously held tenured positions in the Florida Grand Opera, Palm Beach Symphony, and El Paso Symphony. As a student, she was a proud member of the American Youth Symphony, and YMF Debut! Orchestra.

**Melanie Keller**, flute, is from Baltimore, MD. She is Principal Flutist & Personnel Manager of the Vallejo Symphony Orchestra and Opera Idaho Orchestra and performs regularly with the Boise Philharmonic and Boise Baroque Orchestra. She has spent recent summers performing at the Sun Valley Music Festival and with the McCall Summerfest Orchestra. A frequent prizewinner at national flute competitions, she won 1st Place in the 2005 Mid-Atlantic Flute Fair Young Artist Competition. She earned her MM in the studio of Timothy Day at the San Francisco Conservatory and her BM in the studio of Mark Sparks at the Peabody Institute. A passionate educator, she serves as Adjunct Flute Faculty at the College of Idaho, is the flute instructor at the Dunkley School of Music and teaches at the Sun Valley Music Festival Music Institute each summer. Her students have enjoyed participating in the All-Northwest Band, Idaho All-State Band, District and State Solo & Ensemble Festivals, and national flute competitions. Melanie loves spending time with her husband Blaise and their teenage sons, Owen & Jacob.

**Chad Spears**, a native of Boise, ID, has performed across the US, with additional appearances in Canada and Mexico. He has been featured with the Spokane Symphony, Washington-Idaho Symphony, Coeur d'Alene Symphony, and University of Idaho Symphony Orchestra. Chad received his Doctor of Music Degree in Piano Performance at Florida State University under the tutelage of Dr. Read Gainsford. He currently serves as an adjunct instructor for Boise State University's Department of Music, teaching ear training and class piano. He is also the accompanist for the Opera Theatre course and serves as a freelance collaborative pianist for the department. Chad is the pianist for the Boise-based group Tree City Chamber Players and collaborates with TRICA, Alley Repertory Theater, Gemma Arts, Opera Idaho, the Boise Philharmonic, and other Treasure Valley orchestras.
